

PRETTY LITTLE IRON-ONS

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. purchase transfer paper (this can be found online and at most craft stores)
2. print the attached sheet of graphics (they are reversed on purpose) on your transfer paper
3. lay out your fabric (t-shirt, pillow case, etc) on a flat surface (preferably an ironing board) and smooth out any wrinkles with an iron
4. place the transfer on the fabric with the image-side down, where you would like it to be
5. if you're transferring onto a shirt, place a paper bag inside the shirt between the front and back so that it does not transfer through to the back of the shirt
6. after carefully reading the instructions that came with your particular paper, iron the transfer onto your fabric
7. make sure to keep the iron moving in circular motions to prevent it from burning the paper
8. LEAVE THE IMAGE TO COOL!
9. after allowing the paper to cool for a bit, remove the backing from the transfer paper slowly
10. your pretty little iron-on project is now complete!

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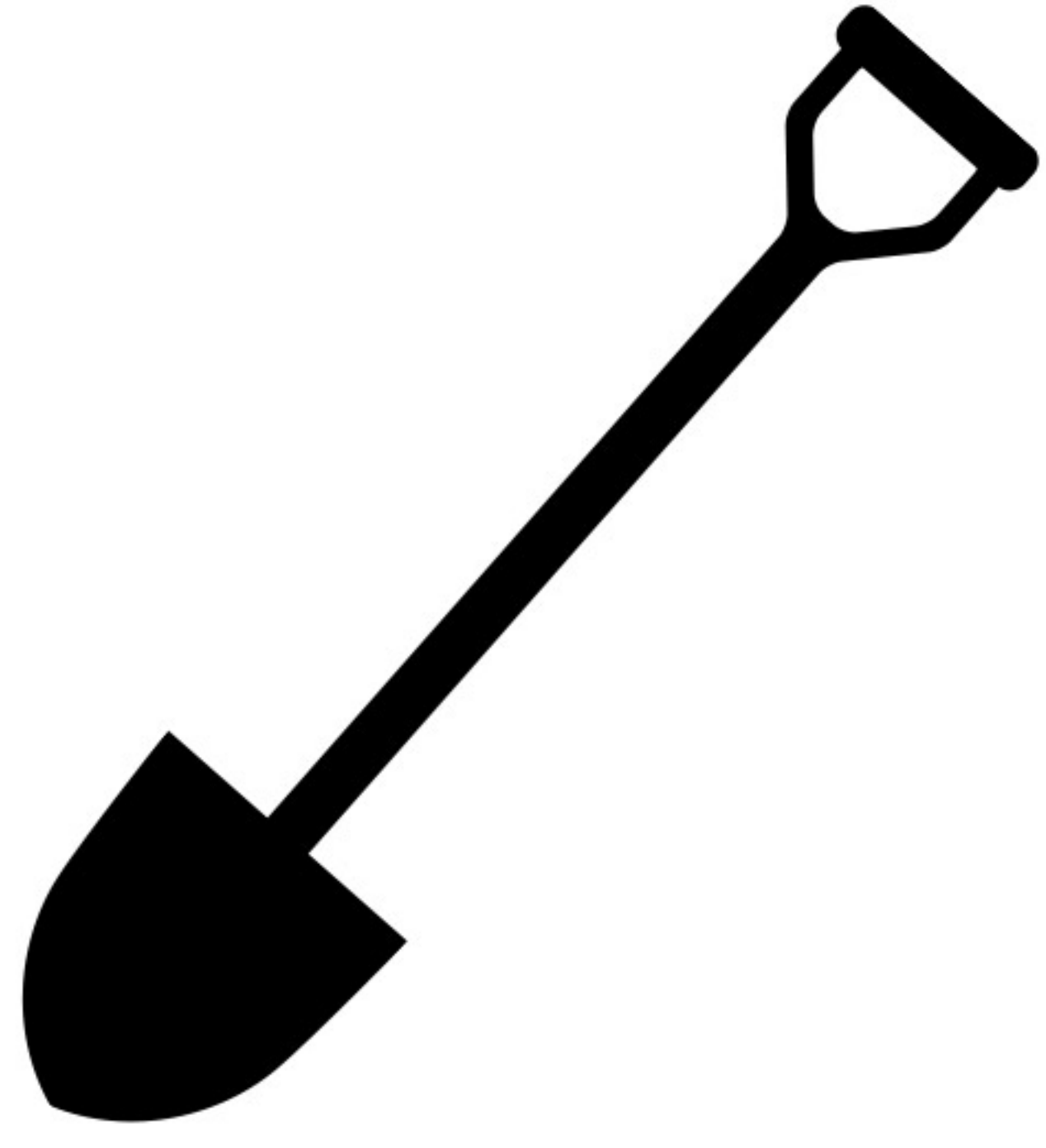
